He has also met with representatives of the Construction Program at Alfred State College to investigate a partnership with their faculty and students. 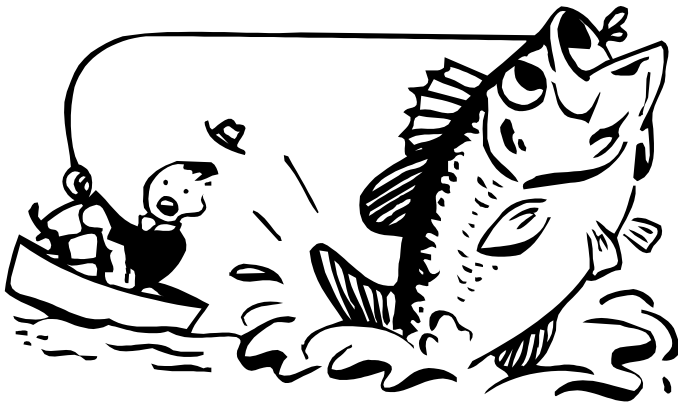
