Understanding Your Public Library's 2026 Budget Vote

Budget Narrative

The Fred & Harriet Taylor Memorial Library of Hammondspport and the Pulteney Free Library are working together to establish a single library funding referendum through a public vote based on Hammondspport Central School District boundaries. This approach would not only strengthen library funding, but also eliminate the double library tax currently paid by about 25% of Pulteney residents—a situation created when the Prattsburg Library moved to school district funding in 2017.



When the new library opened in 2019, taxes were not increased. Since then, only modest increases have been requested to support daily operations. Now, the Board is planning for long-term sustainability and hopes to bring to life several ideas shared by community members before the library was built. Those priorities are reflected in the proposed 2027 budget.

The budget supports expanding our collection with more requested authors and series, offering additional programs with instructors and performers, and increasing open hours. To do this, we plan to add staff and increase staff hours.

This funding would also allow us to begin planning improvements to the library basement, including an exterior entrance and a dedicated space for Storycraft programs. As the building continues to age, it will also help us keep up with essential maintenance and repairs.

The Pulteney community built an incredible library, and we are excited to keep growing with you. Thank you for your continued support!
